- It is the responsibility of the purchaser and installer of this kit to verify suitability / fitment of all components and ensure all fasteners and hardware achieve complete and proper engagement. Improper or inadequate engagement can lead to component failure.

#### **Photographic Tip**

**Important** and highly recommended: Take photos of brake system before disassembly and during the disassembly process. In the event, trouble-shooting photos can be life savers. Many vehicles have undocumented variations, photos will make it much simpler for Wilwood to assist you if you have a problem.




Figure 1. Typical Installation Configuration

#### **General Information and Disassembly Instructions**

• Installation of this kit should **ONLY** be performed by persons experienced in the installation and proper operation of disc brake systems. Before assembling this Wilwood ProSpindle kit, double check the following to ensure a trouble free installation.

• Inspect the contents of this kit against the parts list to ensure that all components and hardware are included.

- Make sure this is the correct kit to fit the exact make and model year of your vehicle. This kit is designed for direct bolt-on installation to 1963-1970 Chevrolet C10 Trucks.
- NOTE: The spindle in this kit requires later model 1973-1987 C10 upper and lower ball joints, not included.

• Verify the new hub stud pattern (5 x 4.75 or 5 x 5.00) matches the lug pattern of the vehicles wheels.

#### **Disassembly**

• Disassemble the original equipment front brakes:

Raise the front wheels off the ground and support the front suspension according to the vehicle manufacturer's instructions.

Remove the front wheels and completely disassembly the stock brake system down to the bare spindles, then remove the spindles.

Assembly Instructions (numbers in parenthesis refer to the parts list and Figure 1 on the preceding pages):

•Apply red *Loctite*<sup>®</sup> 271 to the wheel stud (2) threads and install into the hub (3), Figure 1, and Photo 1. Torque to 77 ft-lb. **NOTE:** There are two five lug patterns in the hub (5 x 4.75 and 5 x 5.00). Ensure the correct hub stud pattern is being used to fit the wheel application.

•Install the hub assembly into the spindle (1), Photo 2. Secure using bolts (4), Photo 3. Torque bolts to 100 ft-lbs.



#### Assembly Instructions

•Attach the steering arm (5) to the back side of the spindle (1) using bolts (6), Figure 1 and Photo 4. Torque bolts to 90 ft-lbs.

•Install the Wilwood ProSpindle assembly into place between the upper and lower ball joints, Photo 5. **NOTE:** The spindle in this kit requires later model 1973-1987 C10 upper and lower ball joints, not included. Torque ball joints nuts to Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) specifications. Install new cotter pin, not supplied.

•Install the steering stop bolt (7), Figure 1 and Photo 6. Torque to 25 ft-lbs.

•Attach tie rod end to the new steering arm (5), Photo 7. Torque the tie rod end nut to OEM specifications. Install new cotter pin, not supplied.

•Install the applicable Wilwood brake kit that was purchased separately per the instructions included with that kit.

•After brake kit installation, have a qualified technician perform a front end alignment on the vehicle.
